From an early age I was inclined activities in chess composition. In this regard, he composed many problems direct mates.

Since over ten years he has devoted almost exclusively to the production of studies from various thematic . That is, positions where the tactical movements are essential to make the most appreciated of these studies for fans of resolution.

Peter is a composer prolific and recognized through awards, honors and accolades it has received at various international competitions . However, it appears that their higher purpose is to offer his compositions , lovers resolution and analysts, because many works of significant level, were exposed in magazines and Internet sites that do not do competitions

Then transcribe a series of stories and comments sent to this editorial by Peter S. Krug, relating to its evolution in the difficult "task" of chess composition

“Mit 12 Jahren erlernte ich die Schachregeln. Ich besorgte mir einige Eröffnungsbücher und lernte so autodidakt das Schachspielen.

Schon wenige Jahre danach blitzte ich regelmäßig im Café Mozart. Dabei lernte ich Hermann Hamberger kennen.

Hermann, der ausgezeichnet Englisch kann konfrontierte mich mit klassische Mattaufgaben, wie ein Matt in 3 von Würzburg.

Ich war verblüfft über die Schwierigkeit der Idee, die dahinter stand, aber auch darüber, dass keiner von den anderen Schachspieler imstande war diese Aufgabe zu lösen.

Seitdem habe ich immer, wenn ich Hermann sah gefragt, ob er mir eine neue Aufgabe zeigt.

Hermann zeigte mir viele schöne Aufgaben von Sam Loyd, die alle so schwierig waren, dass ich sie nicht lösen habe können.

Bald versuchte ich schon selbst Mattaufgaben zu komponieren, war aber enttäuscht zu sehen, wie schwer das Komponieren ist.

Mit sehr viel Zeit und Geduld konnte ich aber dennoch 12 Mattaufgaben komponieren.

Hermann nahm meinen Zettel mit den 12 selberkomponierten Aufgaben und übergab dies Rudolf Diess, der damals eine wichtige Position im salzburger Schachleben hatte. Durch Rudolf Diess (gestorben 2012) konnte ich erstmals Schachaufgaben in die Salzburger Nachrichten veröffentlichen.

Ich kann mich noch erinnern, wie überaus glücklich und stolz ich war, wie ich meine erste Mattaufgabe in der Zeitung sah.

Schließlich war ich damals noch keine 17 Jahre alt.

Seitdem hat mich das Problemschach sehr gefesselt. Obwohl ich eigentlich als Schachspieler damals auch schon Erfolg hatte, konnte ich wegen sozialen Notständen (ich hatte keine Mutter und keinen Vater, die mich unterstützten) nicht regelmäßig in Vereinen mitspielen.

Mit den wenigen Geld, das ich hatte kaufte ich mir die Cherónbücher und kam so mit der wunderbaren Welt der Schachstudien in Berührung.

Ich war fasziniert von den Studien Gorgievs und Mattisons, dachte aber niemals daran, selber eine Studie zu bauen.

Da mir die Studien noch schwieriger erschienen als die orthodoxen Mattaufgaben.

Erst als ich mir 1998 einen PC kaufte, konnte ich sogar komplizierte Studien wirklich analytisch bis ins einzelne verstehen.

Das gab mir den Mut, es selber zu probieren. Meine ersten Schachstudien waren überhaupt nicht originell.

Das wurde mir bewusst, als ich die Harold van der Heijden Datenbank 2010 kaufte. Auch als Schachstudienkomponist tat ich mich am Anfang nicht leicht. Ich musste mich erst in die Materie hineindenken.

Dabei half mir die Harold v. d. Heijden Datenbank sehr: Ich konnte am Tag 100te Studien auf einmal verschlingen.

So wuchs ich nach und nach einerseits mit der Hilfe des Computers, andererseits mit Hilfe gewisser Schachforen in die Materie der Schachstudie hinein.

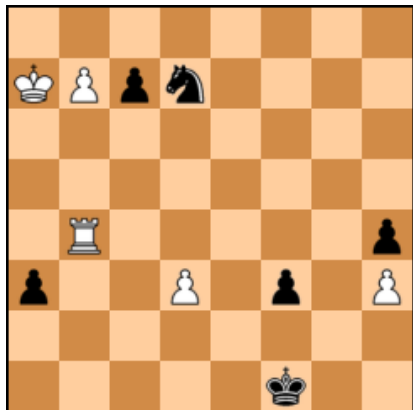
Mittlerweile habe ich weit über 100 Studien komponiert, viele davon wurden ausgezeichnet.

Ich lernte viele wunderbare Menschen aus aller Welt kennen von denen ich wiederum Anregungen und Ermutigungen bekommen habe”.

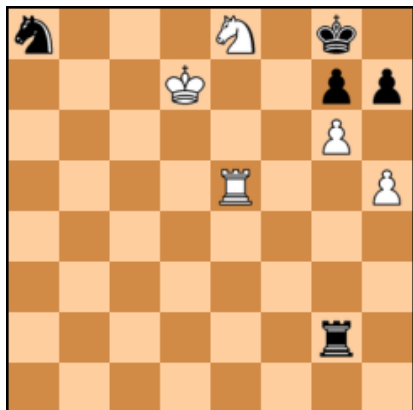

01 1° Prize Ural Problemist - 2013



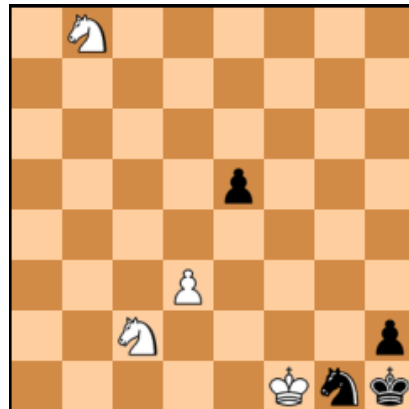

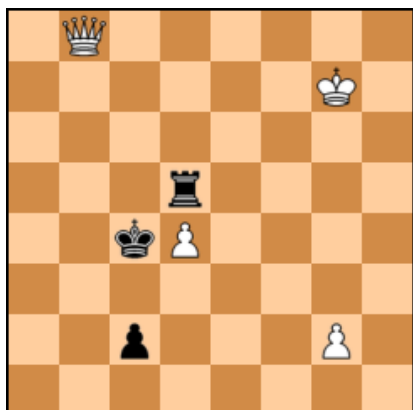

13 Die Schwalbe -2013



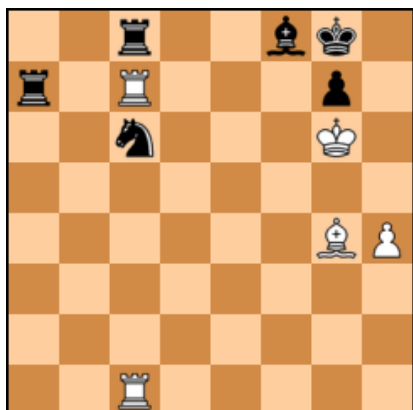
